

2016 Owners, Drivers & fans Survey Summary



The survey has already shaped the 2017 season



Eight clear points of direction emerged

- This was the first survey of those interested in racing 2CVs since 2007
- It has already proved valuable in helping to define the 2017 race season
- Certain points came out very clearly:
 - An early announcement of the race schedule really helps teams and drivers
 - Costs, costs, costs, costs, costs
 - Sprints should be two, 20-min races
 - 24hr in August, ideally a bank holiday
 - Strong preference for Snetterton
 - More a lack of drivers than cars for 24hr
 - Scrutineering needs to be sorted
 - Remaining with Webers is preferred

Broad spectrum of response

- 117 overall replies:
 - 57 Owners
 - 27 Drivers
 - 33 Enthusiasts, pit crew, marshals
- 16 had Club ID plates
- Many intend to race in 2017
 - 15 Sprints & 24hr
 - 3 Sprints only
 - 14 24hr only
 - 17 Undecided
- Sprints:
 - 27 raced in 2016
 - 16 have raced 2010-2015
- 24hr
 - 20 raced in 2016
 - 30 have raced 2010-2015
- Note: some double-counting through multiple ownership of cars



Why have owners not raced their cars?



Costs, costs, costs

• Top 5 issues:

-	Cost	66%
-	Time	50%
-	Moved series / lost interest	25%
-	Development or rule changes	21%
_	Club Politics	7%

- Note: Of cars that no longer race
- In 24hrs only, 30% can't find drivers prepared to cover the costs of racing
- In Sprints only, top three reasons were:

-	Lack of scrutineering	30%
-	Damage	23%
_	No time to test	23%



What 24hr format and costs?



Ideally Snetterton, August bank holiday race, starting in the afternoon for £1,500......

- 90% are prepared to accept an entry fee of £1,500 or above
- 62% need a £500 early bird to pay by 1st May
- 68% are prepared to pay £100 or more for testing. 29% would not test if charged
- Month for 24hr preferred in order: August, July, September, June, May, April
- 61% would prefer a bank holiday weekend
- 16 ranked Snetterton as top choice: 12 Anglesey
- There was no strong preference for start time, with each hour between noon and 1600hrs scoring the same
- An early announcement of date and circuit was deemed important in attracting drivers
