The club has been racing the iconic French Citroen 2CV for over 28 years now. The championship has long been recognised as providing close, exciting racing and a friendly atmosphere, while keeping costs to a minimum. All the cars are basically the same and in the pit lane it is a tradition that members are always happy to help any other member in trouble. This is not always the case in one-make series.

The cars are only allowed to take on 20lts of fuel at any one stop. This lasts for around two hours, when they come in for a fill-up and driver change. Cars have three or four drivers. There is a tow-back rule. If a car stops on the circuit, it will be recovered back to the pit lane allowing the crew to fix it. A good crew can change an engine in just 8 minutes!






Euro 2CV / Dyane Hybrides









For 2018 the amazing Minis are using an early version of the 1275cc engine which they have used at the Spa 2CV 24 Hour. This makes them quicker than a 2CV 602cc and closer to the Furo Hybrides





Underneath they have a Citroen 2CV or Dyane chassis and suspension. The engine is a BMW 850 cc bike boxer engine and the gearboxes are free. They are a lot guicker than a 2CV 602cc. This is the 7th year that this class has been invited to enter the race, and they are the fastest class in the annual Spa 2CV 24 Hour, in October.
